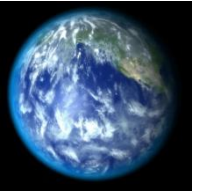
5 Honey Bee Facts

1. A honey bee makes about a twelfth of a teaspoon of honey in its lifetime, so it takes a lot of bees to make a jar of honey!
2. Once honey bee eggs hatch into worker larvae, they'll be fed around 1300 times per day!
3. A honey bee queen may lay as many as 1000 eggs per day as she establishes her colony.
4. If the queen honey bee is removed from the hive, within 15 minutes the rest of the colony will know about it!
5. There is evidence honey bees were on the planet 150 million years ago - that's longer than humans!
